A certified copy of your child's birth certificate must be presented to the preschool office staff by May 1st, 2012. A photocopy of the birth certificate will be kept in your child's file and the original certified copy will be returned to you.

The Registration Fee is \$125.00 per child or \$200.00 for families with more than one child enrolled. Registration fees and tuition payments are non-refundable if you must withdraw from our program.

As a small, private preschool, our resources are limited. We do not employ any special education teachers on staff and cannot make any guarantee about our ability to provide an adequate and appropriate educational setting for a child with special needs. We will make an effort to accommodate a child's special needs, however, when a child's special needs prevent us from providing the program described in our parent handbook, it may be necessary for the family to find a suitable alternative program for their child.

Class assignments are made based on these criteria:

1. Currently enrolled families are given first priority based on length of time family has had children enrolled in the preschool.
2. Siblings and returning families are offered placement next.
3. Remaining openings are offered first to parishioners, then to families in the community.
4. Forms received at Open House receive priority over forms received at a later time.
5. Each class should have a mix of girls and boys and be balanced in terms of birthdays.
6. Requests are carefully considered, but not guaranteed. Requests for children to be grouped together are primarily for those children who do not see special friends away from the preschool.

We welcome children of all faiths to our preschool. While we respect the various faith traditions of non-Catholic children, all children enrolled in the preschool are expected to participate in our Prayer & Praise class. Please talk to the Preschool Director if you have any questions.

Supplies include:

- * Crayons, markers, pencils, watercolors, tempera paints
- * Construction paper and copy paper for classroom activities
- * Craft supplies, i.e., feathers, wiggle eyes, pipe cleaners, cotton balls, glitter, craft sticks, etc.
- * Latex gloves for caring for injuries and diaper changes.
- * Any consummable material used in classroom activities
- * Disinfecting cleaner for toys and manipulatives
- * Laminating film
- * CPSI and ASTM certified mulch for the playground
- * Maintenance of playground equipment

Enrichment includes:

- * Special event days such as Dad's Night Out, Tea for Moms, Art Day, Field Day, Science Day, Dr. Seuss Day, Fire Safety Day, Dental Health Day, etc.
- * Special activities associated with holidays
- * In-house guests such as Music for Kids, The Puppet Guy, Nature Center, etc.
- * Christmas and End-of-the-Year Programs
- * Pre-K Blessing Ceremony
- * Musical Movement equipment
- * Religion instructional materials

Registration Fee provides for:

- * Parent Handbook
- * All printed notices, calendars and newsletters
- * Tuition envelopes and tuition statements
- * Registration forms and student files
- * Student insurance (school hours only – supplements the families' insurance)
- * Staff development training for teachers and office staff
- * Separate phone line for the preschool
- * Worker's compensation for preschool staff
- * Lease and maintenance for copier
- * Utilities and cleaning of building
